## **Level IV: Caring**

Students at Level 4, in addition to respecting others, participating, and being self-directed are motivated to extend their sense of responsibility beyond themselves by cooperating, giving support, showing concern, and helping.

#### Level III: Self-Direction

Students at Level 3 not only show respect and participation, but they are also able to work without direct supervision.

### **Level II Participation**

Students at Level 2 not only show at least minimal respect for others, but also willingly play, accept challenges, and practice motor skills.

### Level I: Respect

Students at Level I may not participate in the day's activities or show much mastery or improvement, but they are able to control their behavior enough so that they don't interfere with the other student's right to learn or the teacher's right to teach.

### Level 0: Irresponsibility

Students who operate at Level Zero make excuses and blame others for their behavior and deny personal responsibility for what they do or fail to do.
