Resume Rubric

1. Exceptional Resume

Resume is truly outstanding - shows great care, time and pride; resume demonstrates information/research both in class and outside of class; resume has the six required categories; resume includes a cover letter; resume is edited for spelling, grammar, etc; resume is beautifully typed or very neatly printed on white paper; resume definitely demonstrates reflection by the student as the explorers aspirations, goals, etc.; resume is turned in on time.

2. Strong Resume

3. Capable Resume
