



Create a Candy Bar & Wrapper Station Parent Directions

- Assist students at this station by guiding them through a brainstorming session. Have them talk about their "creation". Then encourage them to list their ingredients FIRST, then design their cross section.
- 2. Encourage them to use a ruler to design their cross-section. Help them decide which layer will be thin, thick and to illustrate that. If they want a candy in another shape circle encourage them to use an item to trace to insure accuracy. Have them check their list of ingredients to be sure they are all on the cross-section.
- 3. Take time now to create the name. They have had alliteration explained to them. Try to guide them along this route. (example Mike's Minty Mallows)
- 4. Create a wrapper to SELL your product! Make it colorful, creative and ZINGY!!!!
- 5. Begin the descriptive paragraph.

Students should brainstorm all the words they may want to use on the back of one of their worksheets in the packet. Please encourage them to check their chocolate dictionary in their packet first so that all words are spelled correctly as they begin. Other words may be added without asking you how to spell each one. They are used to writing their list this way.

Step two is to create a topic sentence. Students should be able to make this statement regarding their creation. Help if needed,

Encourage them to look at the cross-section diagram to make the descriptive task a little easier for them.
