

Student Sample B - Mangrove Snake

This student received 37/45 points in the area of *Specific Expectations*. The points were awarded based on the following components:

- good description with details,
- more than 2 well-developed interesting facts,
- animal was depicted in its natural surroundings,
- cooperative group described habitat in detail along with its location,
- presentation was complete and clearly spoken with good volume,
- good knowledge of subject
- revisions were made.

Although these components were evident in the paragraph, the student included a minimal description of how the animal adapts to its habitat.

This student received 14/25 points in the area of *General Expectations*. The points were awarded based on the following components:

- the paragraph was completed as assigned,
- the information was accurate,
- 3 - 5 errors were made,
- efforts were made to self-correct and revise,
- sentences were complete,
- project was completed on time,
- directions were followed,
- revisions were required only once.

This student received 16/20 points in the area of *Task Management Skills*. Points were awarded based on the following components:

- use of multiple resources,
- demonstrated good understanding of technology,
- demonstrated good use of encouraging words,
- good effort to participate,
- helpful and cooperative,
- remained on task.
