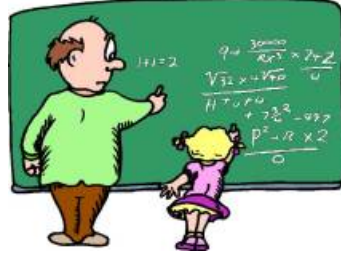


Why do you think authors write?

To entertain means to give pleasure to, to amuse or to tell a story that affects emotions.

This writing takes the form of fiction and may include:

- ✓ novels
- ✓ comic books
- ✓ plays
- ✓ short stories
- ✓ poetry

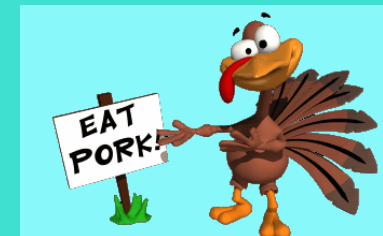


To persuade means to try to convince an audience to believe or not to believe something or to do or not do something.
