When they are picked or cut off, they will stop growing. They cannot make food or grow anymore.





A can and bus can go down the street, and balloons float, but they do not move on their own. They do not grow.




These toys might look like a bear and a baby, but they are not alive. They will never grow, and do not need to eat food or drink water. They do not move on their own.

Great now let's sort some things!!











Title: Frog life cycle (20 of 24)




