Pride and duty should be kept separate; Sometimes pride can get in the way of duty.

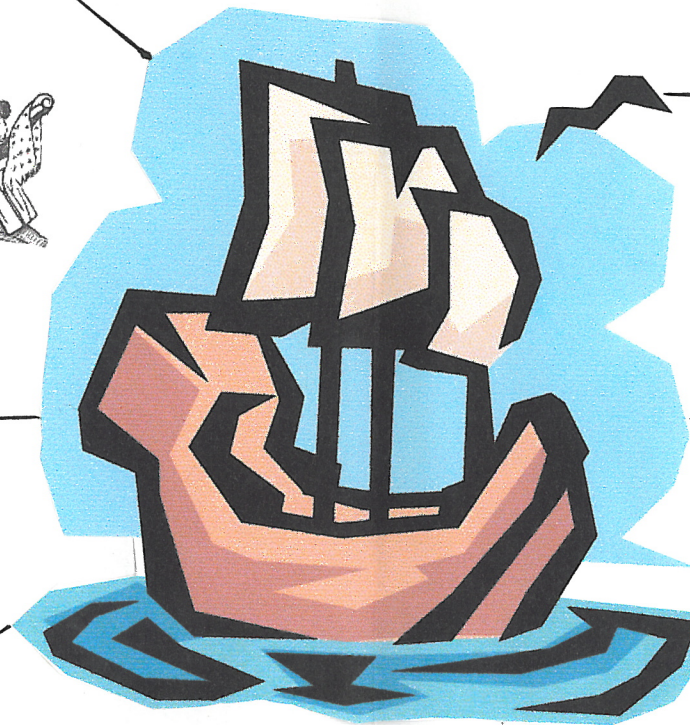
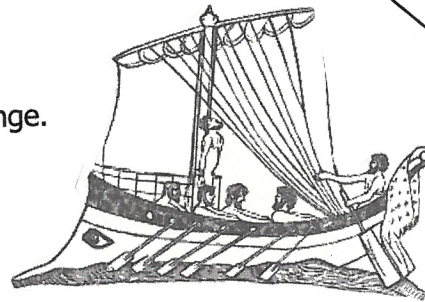

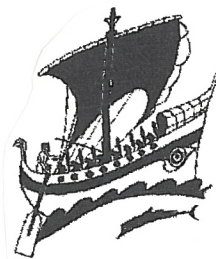
