Read each story problem. Write the letter of the picture that matches the story.

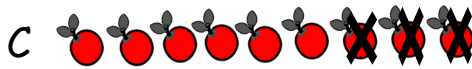
- 1 There are 9 apples on a tree.

How many apples do I have to eat later?



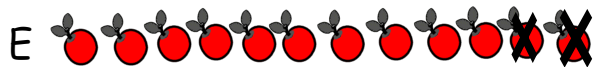
- 3 Mom brought home 8 apples in a bag.
