



Science Lab Safety Rules -

1. Follow all directions given by your teacher and in the laboratory procedures
2. Safety glasses must be worn at all times when working with a flame or dangerous chemical
3. Always walk, do not run in the lab
4. Only sit on the chairs, never sit on the lab tables
5. If you spill any chemicals, notify your teacher immediately,
- 6. NO FOOD OR DRINK IN THE LAB!**
7. Use only chemicals and equipment provided, never go into chemicals cabinets
8. Refrain from drinking, tasting and inhaling chemicals
9. Never smell chemicals directly. *Use the wafting method: use your hand to waft some of the odors towards your nose*
10. Dispose of used materials and chemicals as your teacher instructs.
11. Handle glassware and equipment with care.
12. You should never use broken or cracked glassware.
13. If you break glassware during an experiment notify the teacher.
14. When heating never point the mouth of the test tube at anyone.
15. When heating a test tube or other glassware be sure to keep it away from water.
- 16. If you spill chemicals on yourself , wash off quickly and NOTIFY your teacher IMMEDIATELY**
17. Report all accidents and injuries to your teacher **IMMEDIATELY**
18. Always wash your hands after working with chemicals
19. Familiarize yourself with location of all safety equipment in the lab
20. Keep your work area clean and uncluttered. Leave the area clean when you are done with your experiment
