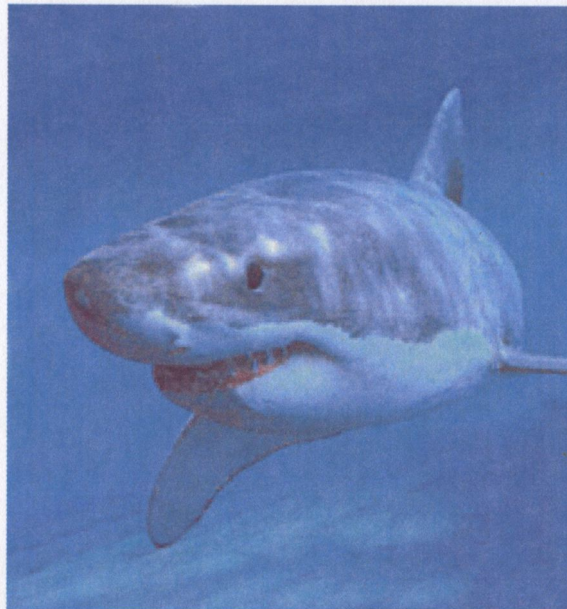


# Great White SHARK
